Summary of Working Conditions in Europe

- Survey results highlight further challenges to the Lisbon Agenda
- Working conditions show considerable variation across Europe
- European workers are generally satisfied with working conditions
- Workers with regular and predictable schedules are more positive about work-life balance
- Work intensification is on the increase
- Health and safety risks are still an issue in new Member States
- Gender gaps (pay, time, employment rate) persist across Europe

Survey of 30,000 workers in 31 countries across Europe on their conditions of work and employment
