## Monitoring impact of migration on EU public services and labour market


- Creation of **NEW Ukraine country profile** and reliable up-to-date database **EUPolicyWatch** with NEW hub for Ukraine on Eurofound website

- Particular **attention to vulnerable groups** and introduction of national measures in the EU as cost of living rises.







# EU PolicyWatch – Monitoring policies to cushion impact of rising inflation and energy prices

Most measures relate to all citizens (41%), while a third of the measures are targeted and commonly aimed at families, people on low incomes or on social benefits

Since March 2022, the EU PolicyWatch database has recorded 121 policies to cushion the **impacts of rising energy prices**



*Measures highlighted in grey are targeted at specific groups of citizens.*





# Eurofound adapted budget to external change



**High inflation and cost of living** in Ireland required substantial shift in resources in operational budget and the staff-related title



**Targeted savings** allowed Eurofound to deliver fully on its 2022 work programme
